Background

Enhancing clinical trials capacity is a priority for the Government of Rwanda, the Ministry of Health, and the Rwanda Biomedical Center (RBC), as part of the ACTIVATE project aimed at advancing clinical research and data science in Sub-Saharan Africa. We seek a Clinical Trial Development Consultant to contribute to the production of a comprehensive report, encompassing baseline data analysis, needs assessment, recommendations, and strategies for strengthening clinical trials capacity in Rwanda.

Position: Clinical Trial Development Consultant

Job description

The consultant will support the development of an investment case report focusing on baseline data analysis, needs assessment, and strategic recommendations for enhancing clinical trials capacity in Rwanda. This short-term assignment (30 days) entails collaborating with stakeholders to assess capacity building needs, providing expertise on lab/technical requirements, and contributing to the production of a costed investment plan.


Duties / Responsibilities/ Scope
