Data Collectors play a vital role in ensuring the success of projects by gathering accurate, reliable data using state-of-the-art tools and methodologies, including REDCap for quantitative data and recorders for qualitative Key Informant Interviews (KIIs) and Focus Group Discussions (FGDs).

Key Responsibilities

1. Data Collection and Management:

- Accurately explain the research project to eligible participants
- Obtain informed consent from research participants or respondents
- Conduct quantitative data collection using REDCap.
- Execute qualitative data collection through Klls and FGDs, ensuring high-quality audio recordings.
- Transcribe and verify qualitative data as required.
- Ensure data integrity and completeness during and after collection.

2. Training and Compliance:

- Attend mandatory training sessions on data collection protocols, REDCap usage, and ethical considerations.
- Follow CIICHIN guidelines for data security, confidentiality, and informed consent.

3. Coordination and Reporting:

- Submit all data, including recorded materials, on time and in the required format.
- Report any challenges during data collection promptly.

4. Travel:

• Be available to travel extensively to designated project locations, including remote and rural areas.
